Multi-day cycling tours are so much fun — but the thought of riding a bike for miles (kilometers!) through a foreign country can sometimes seem intimidating to first-timers. We believe that ExperiencePlus! offers a great balance for all levels of cycling and traveling expertise. On tour, you'll feel adventurous, yet safe... active, yet relaxed... far from home, yet deeply connected to a totally new place. Here's what a typical day might look like:

Imagine waking up in a cozy hotel right in the heart of a small town in Tuscany, Provence, or Chile: shop-keepers are opening for the day, birds are singing, kids are on their way to school. You look forward to breakfast where tour leaders have prepared marked maps for the day and you review your daysheet that lists today's highlights. A day that might look something like this...

- **7-8:30** Enjoy breakfast. Come whenever you are ready.
- **8:45** Pack up, bring your luggage to the lobby, and hop on your bike you can leave whenever the arrows are ready and your bags are loaded into the van.
- **10:45** Stop for a café au lait or gelato and trade an Experience Plus! hat with the barista.
- 12:45 Chalk arrows lead you to the piazza where fellow riders are relaxing at a café. They invite you to join them, but you and the tour leader are on your way to the local market for picnic supplies. You visit the Romanesque church mentioned on the daysheet, then feast under a shady tree.
- **2:00** Follow the arrows along the quiet, meandering roads of the countryside.
- **4:00** Arrive at the next hotel, check in, enjoy a beer (wine/ gelato) and use your map to explore the local sights.
- **6:00** Gather for a group meeting to chat about tomorrow, then walk to a small winery for a taste of the local wines.
- **7:30** Walk to a local restaurant for a group dinner with your fascinating travel companions.
- **9:30** Stroll around the piazza, think about heading to bed... sleep and repeat!



Unlike most bicycle tour operators, ExperiencePlus! invests preparation time to clearly mark each day's route with bright white chalk arrows. These arrows serve as your personal navigation tools, and are a feature of our tours that both first-time and veteran riders appreciate. Even though we provide maps and detailed information about what you'll see, arrows help ensure that your focus is on finding yourself, not finding your way. Each day, you can decide whether to use the arrows to cycle ahead, stick with the group or take a leisurely ride complete with photo ops, snack stops and sightseeing diversions.

A great tour will leave you satisfied at the end of each day — not too tired from the mileage, the climbing or the weather — yet proud of your physical accomplishments. To help you pick the perfect tour for your abilities, we rate each tour and post day-by-day itineraries with mileage amounts online. Tours are rated from 101 to 401 based on a combination of mileage, terrain, and the size and number of hills. Many itineraries include one (often more) place where we spend a second night at the same hotel, giving you a chance to take a day off and rest your legs, or log extra mileage. Adventure seekers dreaming of continental scale, long distance bicycling vacations can look into our 501 ExpeditionPlus! tours, generally scheduled to run once a year.
